PARENTAL ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF MINOR'S COMPUTER/INTERNET USE

It is the policy of the Carthage Free Library that parents, legal guardians, or custodial caregivers are responsible to monitor the information accessed by his or her child under the age of 18, including internet access. Some internet sites are not appropriate for minors. It is your responsibility to address internet safety and security, and urge the minor to never give out personal information or personal identification over the internet, nor arrange to meet anyone via an internet contact.

The library will not assume parental authority. The library is not able to monitor or control the content of information available on the internet and is not responsible for the networked information available. Only if it is brought to our attention that a person is viewing objectionable material will we be able to act. The library is not responsible for any harm, damage, expenses or charges resulting from internet use.

Users agree to follow the policy of the library set up for computer use and internet access. They agree to comply with the laws, including copyright laws, and hold the library harmless from any and all claims, losses and damages resulting from internet activity. Anyone failing to comply will lose internet and computer privileges for a period of time.

All minors under the age of 18 must have this acknowledgement signed by their parent, guardian, or custodial caregiver to be granted computer and internet access. The parent must present this form in person at the front desk.
